## President's Report to Colleagues

Dear IFTA Colleagues,

The New Year has brought much change to the world, with many new risks and new opportunities. With a mountain of liquidity and an absence of risk appetite from the banking sector, financial markets have become very responsive to changing events, and at times very volatile. While economists struggle under such conditions, technical analysts can thrive. Liquidity improves the quality of price data, which leads directly to more reliable technical signals. At the same time, the discipline of technical trading creates a risk management framework that can allow for both volatile and sideways markets. It is not possible to predict what the future will hold for many nations. What is certain is that markets will adjust and that technical analysis will continue to track the investment flows behind those adjustments.

In this environment IFTA continues to grow with two new Members Societies joining the federation in the last quarter. The Croatian Technical Analysis Association (CTAA) joined in January, as a Developing Member. Also joining IFTA from Austria is Vereinigung Technischer Analysten Österreichs (VTAO). On behalf of the IFTA, I would like to congratulate both Zdenko Grdan (CTAA President) and Claus-Bernhard Schütze (VTAO President) and all of their colleagues for the work they have done in establishing technical analysis societies in their respective countries. IFTA now represents 31 societies in 30 countries. With other new country society applications pending, I look forward to even greater numbers in the future.

To bring all Members together, work towards this year's IFTA Conference, hosted by the SMS in Sarajevo and Herzegovina, continues to advance. The dates for the Conference have had to be changed slightly and this year's Conference will be held on

September 22-24, 2011.

There is more detailed information on this in the Conference Director's Report, further in this *Update*.



#### President's Report continued

The IFTA Liaison group recently circulated a draft of the new IFTA Bylaws for members to consider for approval.

I look forward to completing this important project in the coming months. The new Bylaws are intended to bring IFTA's key Corporate Governance documents up to date and in line with global best practice. Their adoption will ultimately require a formal vote involving all Full Member societies, and details of both the proposed changes and voting timetable will be sent shortly to all Liaison officers and Members.

On the Examination and Accreditation side, IFTA has expanded its CFTe I question database, and is now looking to translate these new questions into all of the five different languages offered within the CFTe examination program. As part of this exercise, questions on a number of additional techniques have been added to the database, to allow for a future expansion of the CFTe syllabus. Information on future changes to examination content will be provided well in advance of any changes being implemented, to allow students ample time to prepare for the examinations.

The eagerly anticipated website developments are just about to go live as I write this, with enhancements including global databases for technical analysis presentations, speakers and qualifications. The success of these initiatives will depend entirely on the active support of Members and Colleagues in submitting content for these global resource databases. With active and consistent input, however, I am very confident that these web resources can be of great value to all Members in the future.

## 2011 Conference Update

The date for the 2011 IFTA Conference has been moved up this year to September 22–24. The speaker line up and events are just about finalized and will be first published on the web site, so please check periodically. For now, we can share that speakers include: Rick Bensignor, Chief Market Strategist, Dahlman Rose & Company; David Keller, Managing Director of Research, Fidelity; Jon Person, well-known author and developer of trading methodologies and tools used by professional traders and outside research analysts; Murray Gunn, Chief Technical Analyst, HSBC, Plc; and Edward Ennis, Chief Commodity Analyst, Rothschild Bank, AG among others.

Grace Jan has completed a terrific job of planning and contracting with the venue, Hotel Europe. We have also teamed up with Green Visions in Sarajevo to organize special and personalized tours for the partner program. (Details to be announced on the conference brochure.) For those interested, the registration material will provide a list of local guides and travel agencies delegates may want to contact for travel plans in the region.

Registration for the conference will open up by late April and I look forward to seeing many of you this September in Sarajevo.

# Call for Hosting Proposals for the IFTA 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference

IFTA is soliciting hosting proposals from all member societies for the 25<sup>th</sup> IFTA Conference to be held in 2012. (A quarter of a century of IFTA Conferences, marking the conference as a major milestone for IFTA!)

In cooperation with a host member society, IFTA will finance, contract and organize the IFTA 25th Annual Conference. This allows our members to host a professional international conference on Technical Analysis with leading speakers in the field and to profile their society in the world community of Technical Analysts. The host of the conference will have the opportunity to raise the national profile of their organization, and has the potential to increase revenue for the ongoing work and support of their society. 50% of the conference proceeds will go to the hosting society.

#### **Background:**

The International Federation of Technical Analysts, Inc. (IFTA) was incorporated in 1986 and is a global organization of market analysis societies and associations. This not-for-profit federation has four main goals:

- Provide a centralized international exchange for information, data, business practices, local customs and all matters related to technical analysis in various financial centers.
- Provide meetings and encourage the interchange of material, ideas and information for the purpose of adding to the knowledge of colleagues of individual societies and associations.
- Foster the establishment of local (country) societies of technical analysts around the world.
- Encourage the highest standards of professional ethics and competence among technical analysts worldwide.

The first annual IFTA conference was held in Tokyo in late 1988. This intellectual exchange was followed by a second conference in London in October 1989, under the tutelage of host, Robin Griffiths, President of the British Society of Technical Analysts (STA) at the time. Since then IFTA has continuously held an annual conference, in different locations throughout the world, that is hosted by a different host society, in October or November each year. #### Call for Hosting Proposals continued

In close coordination with the host member, IFTA will be responsible for the following:

- Site selection
- Contract negotiations
- Hotel logistics
- Sponsorship packaging and solicitation and contracting
- Programming
- Exhibits management
- Special event coordination
- Audiovisual production
- Registration
- Marketing
- Financial management

This allows The Host Society to do what it does best—help determine the site, theme, program and "personality" for the Conference. The Host Society will define the vision for the Conference while IFTA's focus will be on its execution. The Host Society shares in revenue from the Conference while avoiding any financial exposure.

Suggested information guidelines in a submitted proposal are:

- If possible, the proposed Conference location should be within 30–45 minutes taxi-drive from an international airport.
- Conference venue should be held in the same hotel as where delegates

- are staying (or at least within a short walking distance).
- If you already have ideas on possible conference venues, please include this information.
- Information about the location for the proposed conference, including lists of possible venues, transportation overview, cultural and touristic points of interest
- Climatic conditions between the months of September and November
- A theme or themes for the Conference you would like to host
- Preliminary ideas you may already have for off-site Conference events
- Ideas you may have for spouse/partner events parallel to the Conference
- If you already know, a list of speakers you think you would like to invite to the conference
- Names of potential local sponsors
- The name and contact details of your Conference Chair
- Any additional information you think is important to evaluate your proposal
- Why your society is best positioned to host the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual IFTA Conference.

On Thursday, March 10, 2011, the Ecole Supérieure des Affaires (ESA) and the Lebanese Society of Technical Analysts (LSTA) organized the launching of the LSTA Society, at the ESA Fattal auditorium. Despite very bad weather conditions, there were 105 attendees!

ESA Dean Director General Stéphane Attali first welcomed the guests, followed by LSTA President Grégoire Azar who presented the association and executive committee members. Azar then outlined the objectives of the association:

- Refine the technique of traders/dealers in Lebanon, by providing them
  with new analysis methods and helping them make forecasts and develop
  new trading strategies.
- Organize informative technical analysis events and seminars with local and international experts.

All references are to be included as endnotes. No separate list of references or bibliography should be provided.

Illustrations and charts must be referred to by Figure Number and source (when applicable). Tables must be referred to by Table Number and source.

#### **Length Of Contribution**

Papers should be approximately 1200 to 3000 words, with supporting graphs and charts.

#### **Format**

We ask for submission in MS Word or other text format. PDF format will not be accepted. Charts and graphs may be in gif or jpeg, but we ask that authors also keep a tif format in case it is required for printing purposes. An Excel spreadsheet supporting your submission may also be submitted.
